



Countertop Measuring Guide


1 Draw a diagram of your countertop space on graph paper.




2 Include the spaces for your sink(s), cooktop or range, dishwasher(s), etc.




3 Indicate where the walls are in the space (if possible).



4 Measure the dimensions of each countertop section in inches, both length and depth. Round up all numbers to the nearest half-inch.



5 For each section, multiply the width by the length and divide by 144.



6 Once the square footage for each area is calculated, add them all together to calculate the final square footage.

$$\begin{array}{r} 25.67' \\ + \\ 18.21' \\ + \\ 13.72' \\ \hline \text{Total Square Footage } 57.59' \end{array}$$
